

INSTRUCTORS FOR MULTICULTURAL FATHERHOOD WORK

Helsinki NMKY's multicultural fatherhood work promotes the well-being and inclusion of fathers, children, and families within Finnish society. The project offers both group activities and individual guidance and support. Our core values are equality and respect, with a focus on the child's right to a good and balanced childhood and upbringing.

We are currently seeking peer facilitators for part-time work in activities that enhance the well-being of divorced fathers. The goal of the initiative is to strengthen fathers and their resources and promote the well-being of fathers and children. The project includes activities such as group sessions in the fathers' native languages, as well as activities and leisure-time programs for fathers and children.

Main tasks:

- Initiating and developing group activities with support from the fatherhood project team.
- Collaborating with the target group and communities: informing communities about the project and its activities, identifying the needs of the target group, and recruiting participants.
- Facilitating groups and activities.

The part-time work will consist of approximately 30 hours until the end of 2024, with the possibility of continuing into 2025 (about 5 hours per week). You will receive training, and the entire project team will support you in your tasks.

You are the person we are looking for, if:

- You have personal experience with fatherhood and/or professional expertise in issues related to parenting and divorce.
- You are reliable and committed to promoting the well-being of fathers and children.
- You possess good social skills, can facilitate discussions in an inclusive manner, and want to support fathers who are in difficult life situations.
- You have strong problem-solving skills and a flexible attitude, can work independently as well as part of a team, and are open to learning new things.

We particularly value language skills, networking abilities, and personal experience with co-parenting and settling in a new country.
